How about getting crafty.....

It's good to learn about the Holy Spirit following on from Easter. Read the following passages and find out about how the Holy Spirit works. Perhaps try some of these crafts....

John 14: 25 – 26,

John 15: 26 – 27,

John 16: 8 – 15

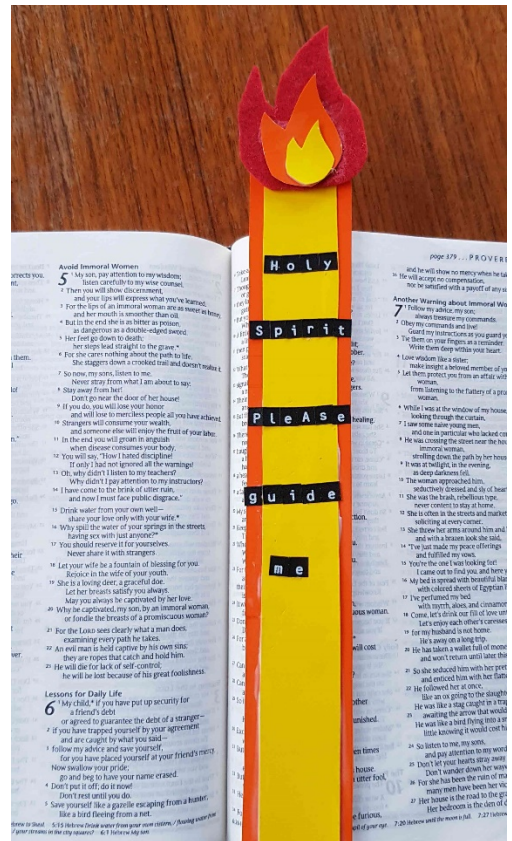


(Trace your palm onto white paper. Cut it out and paste onto coloured paper. Add a beak, an eye and legs so your dove is complete. Add four statements about the Holy Spirit.)

Create a bookmark for your bible. Glue two strips of card together (one wider than the other). Paste three flames at the top, each slightly smaller than the one before. (Use red, orange and yellow card or felt.)

Write:

‘Holy
Spirit
Please
guide
me’



Create a dove by cutting up one paper plate (as demonstrated below). Sticky tape the wings to the back. Draw or cut out the beak and legs. Write four statements about the Holy Spirit on the wingtips.

Or you could even try fitting a memory verse onto a scrabble board, finding nifty ways to connect the words together.
